The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that John Purdie be allowed \$ 3.00 relief monthly.

Upon motion of Commissioner Floyd, seconded by Commissioners Stephens and Jordan, and passed, it was ordered that a written request be signed by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County to the County Board of Elections of Columbus County, North Carolina, requesting in writing that said County Board of Elections call a county election to be held on the question of setting up and operating in Columbus County, North Carolina, a liquor store or stores as provided by Section 18-61 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.

It is further ordered that said written request be delivered to the County Board of Elections on this the 2nd day of May, 1949.

Ordered: that due to cost of holding elections, the Board of Elections be requested to call for A B C Election on June 4, 1949, along with State Bond Election.

Ordered: that resignation of W. R. Crook, Asst. County Agent, be accepted.

Ordered: that the Courthouse be closed May 30th, for Memorial Day.

Ordered: that real estate in Chadbourn Township, listed to Mrs. E. L. Derrick and described as 1 lot Theater be reduced from \$ 5,830 to \$5,000.

Ordered: that real estate in Chadbourn Township, listed to E. L. Derrick and described as 3 lots 1st Ave. be reduced from \$ 4,895 to \$ 4,000.

Ordered: that the tax collector be allowed to appoint fee Deputies to collect personal property tax at a fee of 25% for 1947 and prior years and 10% of 1948 collections.

Ordered: that all land upon which taxes for 1948 have not been paid be allowed advertised and sold the first Monday in July, and that notice of said sale days be advertised in the paper according to statute.

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Take over and maintain that section of road beginning on the Old Wilmington road near Edna Creech's and extending northwardly about 1.2 mi. to the White Hall road.

WHEREAS, the attached petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of the county of Columbus requesting that the above described road, the location of which has been indicated in red on the attached map, be added to the system of county roads now maintained by the State Highway and Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System and its maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.
