The following business was transacted:

On motion of Commissioner W. F. Floyd and seconded by Commissioner D. H. Jordan, it is ordered that Commissioner W. A. Weir serve as Chairman Pro Tem.

Ordered: that James Lacy Herring, Whiteville Township, be relieved of poll tax in Columbus County as he is physically disabled.

Ordered: that Maggie Pittman, Evergreen, N. C., be placed on Out Door Poor List for \$ 5.00 a month for T. C. Pittman who is an invalid.

On motion of Commissioner Bud Stephens and seconded by Commissioner W. F. Floyd, it is ordered by unanimous vote that Mrs. Johnsie R. Nunn, retired Welfare Supt., not be paid for services through June 15th, as per her request.

Ordered: that Purney Mae Watts, Tabor City, N. C. be given \$5.00 present relief.

Ordered: that Mrs. J. C. Singletary, Tabor City, N. C., be appointed to the County Library Board for a six year period to succeed her expired term of two years.

Ordered: that the Chairman and Clerk be authorized to sign and deliver to the Columbus County Board of Education a 99 yr. lease for a certain tract of land in Whiteville Township containing 4 acres more or less to be used for garage and parking lot for county school buses.

Ordered: that the 1930 tax listed in the name of Tessie Mitchell, Whiteville Township, be cancelled and tax collector be granted refund as this was listed in error, also court cost be cancelled and non-suit be taken.

Ordered: that A. C. Hinson, Williams Township, be granted refund in the amount of \$ 2.04 as he paid poll tax in New Hanover County for 1948.

Ordered: that A. V. Norris be granted a refund in the amount of

\$ 2.42 on his 1948 tax as this amount was charged to him in error.

Ordered: that the 1939, 1940, 1941, 1942, 1943, 1944, 1945, 1946, and 1947 poll tax listed in the name of Clyde Manning, South Williams be cancelled as this man is dead.

Ordered: that Roy H. Meadows, Western Prong Township, be granted refund in the amount of \$ 1.35 as this amount was charged to him through error.

Ordered: that Polly Strickland be granted Out Door Poor Check in the amount for \$ 5.00 per month for 6 months for Barbee Strickland who is physically disabled.

Ordered: that Luther Summersett, Whiteville, and Mrs. Sammy Harrelson, Tabor City, be removed from Out Door Poor List as they have been placed on Old Age Assistance by the Welfare Dept.

Ordered: that real estate listed in the name of Thomas Langley, Heirs, Chadbourn Township and described as 1 Lot Negro Town be reduced from \$1,100 to \$ 400.
