Ordered: that 2 operators for the Radio System at the rate of \$35.00 per month with Tabor City sharing \$17.50 and Whiteville sharing \$6.50 of the expense. This amount to be paid in advance to the County by the Towns.

Ordered: that Audit Report of County Funds for year 1948-1949 as prepared by S. Preston Douglas, Certified Public Accountant, be accepted.

Ordered: that contract for audit of County records for year beginning July 1, 1949, and ending June 30, 1950, be awarded to S. Preston Douglas, Certified Public Accountant, at the rate of \$17.50 per day for each Accountant's time.

TO THE TAX COLLECTOR OF COLUMBUS COUNTY

You are hereby authorized, empowered and commanded to collect the taxes set forth in the tax books, filed in the office of tax collector, and in the tax receipts herewith delivered to you, in the amounts and from the taxpayers likewise there is set forth, and such taxes are hereby declared to be first lien on all real property of the respective taxpayers in Columbus County, and this order shall be a full and sufficient authority to direct, require and enable you to levy on and sell any real or personal property of such taxpayers, for and on account thereof, in accordance with law.
