

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office May 1, 1950, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Sam Caswell be allowed \$5.00 present relief for Mack Page.

Ordered: that Jack Wilson, Tabor City, be allowed \$5.00 present relief.

Ordered: that Mrs. Maude Duncan, R-3, Whiteville, be allowed \$5.00 present relief and \$5.00 on June 1st.

Ordered: that Mrs. Audrey Young, Hallsboro, be allowed \$5.00 present relief and \$5.00 on June 1st.

Ordered: that J. C. Cribb, South Williams Township, valuation on 5 lots be reduced from \$330. to \$165. and effective on 1950 listing.

Ordered: that the Board of County Commissioners request jointly with the Board of Trustees of Columbus County Hospital, Inc. that the N. C. Medical Care Commission send an engineer to make a survey of the hospital in view of obtaining Federal funds to erect a new wing at the hospital.

Ordered: that the offices of the Courthouse be allowed to close at 12:00 on Saturdays.

Ordered: that the Courthouse be closed Tuesday, May 30th, in observance of Memorial Day.

Ordered: that all land upon which taxes for 1949 have not been paid be allowed advertised and sold the first Monday in July, and that notice of said sale days be advertised in the paper according to statute.

Ordered: that the 1949 tax listed on penalty list to R.E.A., Shallotte, in Lees Township, be cancelled and the tax collector given a release therefor, as this property is not taxable.

Ordered: that the following action be taken concerning the tax of Mrs. Amanda Shipman in Whiteville Township:

1946 tax be segregated and Sanford McBride's lot be valued at \$800.00 and he by paying the tax and penalty on \$800.00 valuation shall have his lot released from this lien; the remainder of said tax being on two lots owned by J. N. Coburn.

1947 and 1948, the total valuation be reduced by \$605.00 and that Sanford McBride's lot be valued at one third of the remaining valuation and the balance of the valuation is against the Coburn lots. The reason for the deduction in these valuations is due to a house on the McBride lot having burned.

1949 valuation be reduced by \$880.00 and the tax on the remaining valuation is against the Coburn lots. The McBride lot having been listed separately in 1949.

That the tax collector be given a release for the tax on the reduction in values.
