The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the 1948 and 1949 taxes of Wilton R. Parker, Chadbourn Township, be allowed paid at par, with no penalty added.

Ordered: that donation up to \$1,000 be allowed Columbus County Tuberculosis Association for a county survey and to be included in 1950-51 County Health levy.

Ordered: that Mr. W. S. Edmund and the Columbus County Tuberculosis Association be extended a vote of thanks from the Board of Commissioners for the excellent job of promoting the county survey for tuberculosis victims.

Ordered: that bond of D. M. Phipps for \$1,000 be accepted as Constable's Bond for Jessie Williams as bond of Ned Watts is cancelled as of June 5, 1950.

Ordered: that Mrs. Alice S. Wright, Supt, of Welfare, advise the N. C. Sanatorium that the County will be responsible for operation for Marshall Floyd, a tuberculosis patient from this county.

Ordered: that Mrs. Alice S. Wright, Supt. of Welfare, be allowed to place Maurice Watkins, age 16, in the County Boarding Home, temporarily until placement can be made in Caswell Training School.

Ordered: that the 1949 tax value listed in the name of Henry J. Martin, Whiteville Township, be reduced from \$1,160 to \$600 to correct error in valuation on his automobile and tax collector be given release on \$560 valuation.

Ordered: that the 1949 tax listed in the name of Clanton Wright, South Williams Township, be cancelled and tax collector be granted release as this was double listed.

Ordered: that the 1949 tax listed in the name of Mrs. Ruth Gore, South Williams Township, be cancelled and tax collector be granted release as this was double listed.

Ordered: that the 1935 and 1936 tax listed in the name of Elna Norris Nealey, Williams Township, be cancelled and tax collector be given a release as this was double listed for these years and court cost cancelled and non-suit be taken.
