

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office July 10, 1950, according to adjournment.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that \$5.00 present relief be allowed Mrs. W. J. Anderson.

Ordered: that the County Commissioners recommend to The State Highway Commission to abandon the road leading from the Hallsboro Road through The Honey Hill Section to the intersection to the intersection at the home of Viola Sasser. It is further ordered that the Commission be requested to take over and maintain a portion of road leading from the Honey Hill Road to above mentioned intersection as this is a shortened route.

Ordered: that upon payment of \$344.84 a deed for the Martha McQueen 29 acre tract of land in Ransom Township be made to Estella Cooper and Earl Freeman.

Ordered: that dental work for M. A. Floyd, T B Sanatorium Patient, not be paid for by the County.

Ordered: that the county assume the responsibility of the baby of Lenzie Godwin, T B Patient, for a 90 day period retroactive to June 1st.

Ordered: that Constable's Bond of Cliff Hughes be accepted by the Board of Commissioners.

Ordered: that the audit report as prepared by S. Preston Douglas, Certified Public Accountant, for the records of Clerk of Superior Court be accepted as presented and that Mr. Douglas be awarded contract for the 1950 audit at the rate of \$17.50 per day for Junior Accountants and \$20.00 per day for Senior Accountant in charge.

Ordered: that Millie Ann Williams be granted refund for \$10.00 over payment on 1924 tax, Whiteville Township, listed to Mob Williams, Estate, and that refund check be issued to tax collector to be applied on taxes listed in the name of Millie Ann Williams, Whiteville Township.

Ordered: that the 1949 personal tax listed in the name of Mrs. C. H. Cothran, Tatum Township, be cancelled and tax collector be granted release as this lady now lives in another state.

Ordered: that the 1949 poll tax listed to A. S. Kelly, Ransom Township, be cancelled and tax collector be granted release as this man paid poll tax in Bladen County for 1949.

Ordered: that \$3,570.40 be transferred from the Revolving Fund to the General County Fund to close out the Revolving Fund for the year 1949-50.

Ordered: that the J. H. Williams Heirs taxes in Ransom Township for years 1945, 1946, and 1947, be segregated so that Rodney Carroll may pay the tax on the 2.8 acres thereof owned by him and his wife, the valuation on said 2.8 acres being \$50.00, and upon the payment of this tax by him on \$50.00 valuation for each of said years the 2.8 acres owned by him and his wife are thereby released from the lien of said tax.

Ordered; that property value for 1 acre owned by Henry & Mary Butler in Waccamaw Township be reduced from \$2,255 to \$1,055.

STATE MAINTAINED COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the attached petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of the county of Columbus requesting that the above described road, the location of which has been indicated in red on the attached map, be added to the system of county roads now maintained by the State Highway and Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System and its maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said county.

NOW THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.
