Ordered: that no action be taken on recommendation of location of bridge across the Cape Fear River between Elizabethtown and Wilmington at this time.

Ordered: that Mrs. Geraldine Bursey, Tabor City, be allowed \$5.00 present relief.

Ordered: that order relative to W. H. Haynie Estate tax in Waccamaw Township be reinstated as passed Oct. 2, 1950.

Ordered: that Mrs. Venie H. Rouse be allowed to fill in abstracts for 1951 tax listing showing all information except personal property and real transfers to be completed by tax listers.
