Ordered: that the County assume responsibility of one-half of bill amounting to \$398.50 with The North Carolina Baptist Hospital, Winston-Salem, N. C., for Marion Perritt, age 10, provided the County shall not share any further responsibility for said case.

Ordered: that J. C. Bell, Jr., South Williams Township, be given a cash refund in the amount of \$29.07 on a valuation of \$17.10 for an automobile listed to him through error.
