Ordered: that Elsie Carter, 400 S. Franklin St., Whiteville be allowed \$5.00 present relief.

Ordered: that the Whiteville City School Unit be allowed to reallocate that portion of \$10,000 Capital Outlay from 1950-51 Budget necessary to supplement state funds to erect and equip two toilets for Central High School.

Ordered: that Hugh Nance be allowed a radio receiver set for his automobile.

MEAT ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE SLAUGHTER AND INSPECTION OF MEAT  
IN THE COUNTY OF COLUMBUS

Be it ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County in a session duly held on the 5th day of March, 1951, that the following rules and regulations governing meat inspection in Columbus County shall apply to certain persons, firms or corporations engaged in the slaughter of meat producing animals, preparation, distribution and selling of meat or meat products within the said County as is set forth in paragraph seven of this ordinance.

1. The North Carolina Meat Inspection Act, Chapter 181, as ratified by the General Assembly of North Carolina, March 9, 1925, and the regulations governing the Meat Inspection Act as approved by the North Carolina Board of Agriculture are hereby adopted, A copy of this Act and the Regulations are attached hereto.

2. The County Health Department is hereby empowered to employ a qualified veterinarian, subject to the approval of the State Veterinarian, to inspect meat and meat products as prescribed under the law and regulation of the North Carolina Department of Agriculture. Compensation for his services shall be paid by the Health Department of the County of Columbus, but the total paid shall in no event exceed the amount collected by it under the fee schedule herein adopted.

3. A numbered permit may be revoked by the Commissioner of the North Carolina Department of Agriculture or his duly authorized agent at any time when the establishment violates the law or regulations prescribed for the inspection and sanitation thereof.

4. This ordinance shall comply with Chapter 244 of the Public Laws of 1937, and regulations adopted under this law by the State Board of Health.

5. The Columbus County Health Department is hereby designated as the enforcement agency of these rules and regulations except those designated by Law as prescribed under Chapter 181, Public Laws of 1925, and Chapter 244 of the Public Laws of 1937.

6. The following fee schedule shall be applied and be collected by the County Health Department and utilized by them in the payment of said veterinarian for services rendered:

Cows or beef .....	75¢ per carcass
Hogs.....	25¢ per carcass
Veal, sheep, goats and any other small animal.....	25¢ per carcass

7. Paragraph 1 shall apply only to those certain persons, plants or establishments that are issued a permit number by the North Carolina Department of Agriculture.

8. If any word, clause or paragraph of this ordinance is found to be invalid, the remaining section of this ordinance shall be in full force and effect until legally revoked.

These rules and regulations shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of their adoption.
