

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office, June 5th, 1951, according to adjournment.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Mrs. Titus Williamson be appointed to The Columbus County Library Board.

Ordered: that Whiteville City Schools be allowed per capita distribution of Capital Outlay of 1951 tax levy.

Ordered: that the County Library be allowed to move its location to the Whiteville City Hall.

Ordered: that taxes of R. T. Parker, Whiteville Township, be allowed paid for years 1930 and 1934 at par and no court cost allowed.

Ordered: that the 1950 tax listed on the penalty list in Ransom Township in the name of J. A. Burney showing 60 acres of land valued at \$198 be cancelled and the tax collector given a release for same.

Ordered: that the 1946 tax of James A. Burney in Ransom Township be paid at par with no penalties or interest added; and that the 1947 tax of James A. Burney in Ransom Township be permitted to be paid with \$19.62, and that the remainder of said tax plus penalties and interest be cancelled and the tax collector be given a release for same; and the 1948 tax of James A.
