The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Ellen Meyers Hemingway, Lees Township, be relieved of penalty on 1937 taxes and court cost and that tax collector be given release.

Ordered: that Donald Hunt be allowed to paint floors of jail with county furnishing material.

Ordered: that nurses aid be allowed placed at County Boarding Home at \$60.00 per month.

Ordered: that tax listers be paid 15¢ for farm reports.

Ordered: that meeting be called for Nov. 19th, to hear those persons failing to list automobiles for 1951.

Ordered: that A. B. Dawsey be leased county farm for \$1,000 per year for 5 years as he was highest bidder.

Ordered: that J. L. Lewis be relieved of any late listing penalties for 1951.

Ordered: that order relative to J. B. Simpson taxes passed 60 days ago be given an additional 30 days extension beginning Nov. 5, 1951.

Ordered: that the 1924, 1925 & 1926 taxes for Jenkins Bros., Williams Township, be cancelled and that Roy Nealey be permitted to pay the Jenkins Bros. taxes for the years 1927 through 1937 at par and no court cost, provided he pays all the remainder of said tax.

Ordered: that the taxes listed to Dixie Corbett Estate Waccamaw Township for the years 1927 through 1951 be cancelled and the tax collector be given release as this tax was double listed for these years to Albert Ander.

Ordered: that a cash refund of \$10.00 be made to Aiken Loan & Security Co for tax that they paid for Joe B. Spivey, South Williams Township, as he was overcharged \$10.00

Ordered: that the 1930 tax listed in the name of O. W. Williamson, Chadbourn Township, be cancelled and the tax collector be given release as this tax was double listed.
