

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in regular session, Jan. 7th, 1952, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Board of Education be allowed to use old jail building, located on the east side of the present jail building, for office space.

Ordered: that Mrs. A. F. Israel be allowed \$15.00 outdoor poor for Billy Israel.

Ordered: that Troy Boswell, Cerro Gordo, N. C., be allowed privilege of peddlers license in county with no cost to him.

Ordered: that the 1950 and 1951 tax listed in the name of H. D. Rhodes, Chaubourn Township, be cancelled and tax collector be given release as this tax was double listed for these years.

Ordered: that the 1951 tax in the name of Irving Powell Heirs, Tatum Township, be cancelled and tax collector be given release as this property is also listed in Whiteville Township to John Erving Powell.

Ordered: that a cash refund of \$2.00 be made to Johnnie Powell, R-1, Neuse, N. C. for poll tax that was listed to him through error in this county.

Ordered: that the 1927 through 1937 tax for C. B. Williams, Bolton Township, be allowed to be paid at par with no court cost, providing all the remainder of said taxes are paid.

Ordered: that the taxes for 1950 in Bolton Township listed in the name of Mrs. Estelle Carr be segregated so that Elwood E. Martin may pay the tax on the 295 acres listed thereon having a value of \$1,661, and also the 5 acres listed thereon having a value of \$33, and upon the payment by Elwood E. Martin of the tax plus cost and interest on the total valuation of \$1,694 for 1950 the said 295 acre tract and 5 acre tract now owned by him is released from the lien of the 1950 tax.
