

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office March 3, 1952, according to adjournment, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Henry Strickland be allowed \$5.00 present relief.

Ordered: that A. B. Dawsey be allowed to give crop lien for crop at county farm for $\frac{1}{2}$ rent due in advance and be allowed to have this time extended until sale of tobacco crop.

Ordered: that Highway Patrol Office be authorized to move to office vacated by Board of Education. It is further ordered that Sheriff's Dept. be authorized to move to office vacated by Patrol Dept., leaving present office used by Sheriff's Dept. available for an alternate Recorder's Court room.

Ordered: that County Health Officer be requested to quarantine all dogs in Columbus County.

Ordered: that C. A. Farley be paid the sum of \$36.83 for a claim against the county for services heretofore performed.

Ordered: that community building at Crusoe Island on lot given to county by Gaston Suggs and wife be deeded, along with lot, back to Gaston Suggs and wife for the sum of \$500.00, said amount to be paid \$100.00 cash and deed of trust payable Sept. 1, 1952, to cover balance of \$400.00 be given to county by said Gaston Suggs and wife.

Ordered: that Ralph L. Sellers, R-1, Whiteville, Tatum Township, be given a cash refund on a valuation of \$1,500.00 for 1951 tax that was listed to him through error.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release on valuations of \$83.00 and \$330.00 for 1949, 1950, and 1951 tax listed to Effie H. Goodman, Whiteville Township.

WHEREAS, the Carolina Power and Light Company has purchased the franchise and facilities of the Tide Water Power Company, and is now serving Columbus County:
