The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the Extension Service be advised to retain their offices in the basement of Post Office rather than join the P M A and Soil Conservation offices in the Evans building.

Ordered: that Mr. J. P. Quinerly, Asst. County Agent, be requested to take advantage of his retirement as of May 1st, 1951. *Revised - See Page 183*

Ordered: that the taxes of E. T. Ray, Welches Creek Township, be allowed paid at par for the years 1928 through 1938, and non-suit be taken.

Ordered: that Mr. A. W. Clark, Highway Commissioner, be advised that it will be satisfactory to abandon any portion of the Canal Bank Road in Bolton Township provided the new road be built in any of the proposed locations.

Ordered: that \$500.00 be allowed from the 1951-52 Budget to apply on a Community Building in Welches Creek Township in order to secure a 99 year lease on said building for a voting precinct.

Ordered: that a 4 acre tract valued at \$1,188 and a 2 acre tract valued at \$243 listed to Easter Ila Purdie, Chadbourn Township, be deleted from the tax books and that 2 lots listed to same party be reduced from \$660 to \$100.

Ordered: that a 154 acre tract of S. M. Woodward Land in Tatum Township be picked up on the tax books and listed to W. C. Thomas, Evergreen, N. C., for 5 years at \$750.00.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release on the tax on \$2,000 valuation on the property in Ransom Township listed to Alva M. Blake for each of the years 1943 to and including 1946, and that the tax collector be given a refund on the tax on \$2,200 valuation on said property for each of the years 1947 through 1950.

Ordered: that Penn Summersett be re-paid the sum of \$39.89 to reimburse him for the taxes paid by him on \$550 valuation in Whiteville Township for the years 1947, 1948, 1949, and 1950, listed to him through error and paid by him.

Ordered: that the E. A. Moffit taxes in Tatum Township, for each of the years 1933 through 1950 be cancelled and court cost cancelled and tax collector given a release for same as this is listed in error,

Ordered: that Henry Walker be allowed to pay the taxes on the land in Whiteville Township he recovered in the court action wherein he was plaintiff and against D. J. George, said property having been listed in the name of Sarah A. George, and that said land be released from the lien of all prior county taxes upon the payment thereof: It is also ordered that the 1923, 1924, 1925m and 1926 tax listed to Sarah A. George in Whiteville Township, be cancelled and tax collector given a refund for same as this is barred by the statute; It is also ordered that no court cost be collected, and that Henry Walker be allowed to pay the 1927 through 1934 taxes of Sarah A. George in Whiteville Township at par, without any penalties or interest.

Ordered: that W. D. Brooks, County Auditor, is hereby authorized to cancel the judgment of Columbus County vs. S. P. Faircloth, as recorded in Book 12, page 176, in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court as the tax on which this judgment was rendered has been paid.
