The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that \$2,000 be provided in 1952-53 budget appropriation resolution to cover county's portion for Negro County Farm Agent and Clerical assistant.

Ordered: that the tax collector is hereby ordered to sell the tax lien of all taxpayers who owe taxes for the year 1951 that are liens upon real estate, said sale to be held on July 7, 1952 at the Courthouse and as provided in G. S. 105-387. It is further ordered that it is hereby determined that it is not necessary to issue a tax sale certificate if the county is the purchaser at such sale, but that as provided in G. S. 105-388 each tax receipt purchases at such sale, by said county shall be stamped "Sold to the County of Columbus". It is further ordered that said taxes shall be advertised as follows:

Tabor City Tribune shall advertise Williams, South Williams, and Bug Hill Townships.

Columbus County News shall advertise Chadbourn, Tatum, Western Prong, Cerro Gordo, and Fair Bluff Townships.

All other Townships shall be advertised in The News Reporter, Whiteville, N.C.

Ordered: that the personal property and poll tax listed to Willie Davis, Whiteville Township, be cancelled and tax collector be given release as this tax was double listed in Lees Township.

Ordered: that taxes in Bug Hill Township for 1936 listed in the name of D.C. Stephens Heirs be permitted to paid at par and no court cost allowed.

Ordered: that F. T. Richardson tax for 1951 in Chadbourn Township be segregated so that A.W. Lewis, Sr., may pay the tax on 2 lots purchases by him, one valued at \$2610.00 and the other valued at \$110.00, by paying the proportionate part of the personal property tax.

Ordered: that County Accountant be instructed to purchase 10 in. carriage typewriter to be loaned to State Highway/Dept. <sup>Patrol</sup> provided it not be removed from courthouse.
