Ordered: that the County Accountant file budget estimate in the office of the Clerk to Board, where it shall remain for public inspection; and cause a summary there of to be published in The News Reporter on June 12, 1952; and furnish each newspaper in the county with copy of said budget estimate.

Ordered: that Whiteville City Schools be allowed to transfer \$5,000 from C. E. Vocational Education Fund to C. E. General Fund.

Ordered: that indigent patient rate for Columbus County Hospital be increased from \$2.00 per day to \$3.00 and in the case of Old Age Assistance, Aid To The Permanently Disabled, and Aid To Dependent Children Assistance recipients that the county rate be increased from \$1.00 to \$1.50 per day to match state and federal funds, thereby increasing this total rate from \$4.00 to \$6.00 per day.
