The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that J.W. Jones, Jr., R-2, Chadbourn, be appointed as constable for Chadbourn Township upon posting of bond in the amount of \$1,000.00.

Ordered: that John Bass, Evergreen, be appointed as constable for Tatum Township upon posting of bond in the amount of \$1,000.00.

Ordered: that late listing penalty be released from ¹⁹⁵²taxes of John J. Garrell, Jr., in amount of \$10.69 and Mrs. Bertha Mae Garrell for \$1.10 and tax collector be given release. (Williams Township).

Ordered: that Courthouse be closed on Labor Day and that Board of Commissioners meet on Tuesday, Sept. 2, 1952.

Ordered: that Miss Alice Lowe, Chadbourn, and Mrs. H. H. Bullock, Chadbourn, be re-appointed on the Columbus County Library Board.

Ordered: that the lot purchased in Jan., 1952, by James Harold Sessions from T. J. Chandler and D.C. Corbett be valued at \$250.00. It is further ordered that the taxes of D. C.
