Ordered: that washing machine be purchased for county jail.

Ordered: that electric water heater be installed in kitchen of county home building.

Ordered: that one clerical worker be allowed in county agents office with county paying salary of \$100.00 per month for remaining part of fiscal year.

Ordered: that courthouse be closed Tuesday, Nov. 11, for Armistice Day.

Ordered: that courthouse be closed Nov. 27, for Thanksgiving.

Ordered: that J. D. Peterson be authorized to repair roof of county home building at the cost of \$350 and to repair and replace gutters at the cost of \$550. It is further ordered that Burns Bros. be employed to repair or replace and paint boxing before new gutters are placed.
