

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office June 9, 1953, at 2:00 P. M., according to adjournment.

The following business was transacted:

After a careful study of the 1953 - 1954 Budget as prepared and presented by Alice S. Burns, County Accountant, the following portions of the budget were tentatively approved:

General County Fund on motion of Commissioner Stephens, seconded by Commissioner Buffkin and carried.

Special Levy Fund on motion of Commissioner Council, seconded by Commissioner Thompson and carried.

Service Officer Fund on motion of Commissioner Stephens, seconded by Commissioner Thompson, and carried.

County Debt Service Fund on motion of Commissioner Council, seconded by Commissioner Buffkin, and carried.

Ordered: that the County Accountant file a copy of budget estimate in the office of the Clerk to Board, where it shall remain for public inspection; and cause a summary thereof to be published in The News Reporter on June 10, 1953; and furnish each newspaper in the county with copy of said budget estimate.

Ordered: that oak table and chairs be purchased for use in office of County Commissioners.

Ordered: that one house and lot listed to Mrs. J. E. Gilmore, Whiteville Township, be reduced from \$1,650 to \$1,000.

Ordered: that the E. Cooper Estate tax for 1927 in Bolton Township be settled for \$24.60 and the tax collector given a release for the remainder thereof, in order to effectuate an order of the Board of Commissioners on Dec. 30, 1942, pertaining to this same land as listed at that time in the name of Ed Bookard and Dave Richardson.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned until July 6, 1953.
