Section 2. There is hereby levied, assessed, and ordered collected for the fiscal year 1954-1955, in addition to the tax on property, \$2.00 on each poll on all persons with the county who are liable for the payment of poll taxes.

Section 3. There is hereby levied and ordered collected annually from any person owning or keeping about him in the County of Columbus any open female dog of the age of six months or more a license or privilege tax of \$2.00; and any person owning or keeping any male dog, or female dog other than an open female dog of the age of six months or older shall pay annually on each dog so owned or kept a license or privilege of \$1.00.
