

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met Oct. 4, 1954, at 10:00 A. M., it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that tax deed for property of Roosevelt & Taft Williamson be sold to Raymond Kissam for \$350.

Ordered: that contract in the amount of \$4997.00 be awarded R. C. Lamb & Son for conversion of courthouse heating system according to specifications of William Moore Weber, Architect.

Ordered: that Chairman of Board be instructed to negotiate bid with J. D. Peterson for roof at County Home building.

Ordered: that two water coolers be purchased for courthouse.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release of the tax on \$1675 valuation on the 1954 tax of Thomas Monroe in Tatum Township because of an error in the listing of a house on said premises.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release of the tax on \$2650 valuation on the 1954 tax of Mary Lee Lennon in Tatum Township because of an error in the listing of a house on said premises.

Ordered: that P. E. Norris be permitted to settle the 1934 tax of P. L. Norris (now changed to P. E. Norris) in Williams Township at par plus 10 per cent.

Ordered: that H. C. Formy Duval be given a refund of \$2.00 poll tax on 1954 tax, as this was charged in Brunswick County.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release for receipt #125 Ransom Township of Sam K. Caines in the amount of \$7.22 for an automobile listed to him through error.
