

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met Dec. 6, 1954, at 10:00 A. M., it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that real estate listed to C. L. Blackburn, Chadbourn Township, be reduced from \$3850 to \$2350 and tax collector be given a release on 1954 taxes as an error occurred in listing.

Ordered: that Elery Taylor, Chadbourn Township, be given a refund of \$2.00 as he was not living in the county and not subject to pay poll tax.

Ordered: that the taxes of Rufus C. Benton Heirs in Tatum Township be segregated so that Alton P. Lewis may pay $\frac{1}{4}$ of the original tax plus $\frac{1}{4}$ of the penalties and interest for the years 1949 through 1954.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release in the amount of \$2.30 on 1954 tax of Garland Ward, Lees Township, as this was a late listing charged through error.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:00 Noon at which time the Chairman announced that the Board would re-convene in the court room at 12:00.
