(a) That an order authorizing \$740,000 School Building Bonds of the County of Columbus was finally passed on January 24, 1955, which order was approved by the vote of a majority of the qualified voters of said County who voted thereon at an election duly called and held on Maych 5, 1955.

(b) That it is necessary to fix the details and form and manner of execution of said bonds.

(c) That the period of the life of the school buildings to be erected, remodeled and enlarged pursuant to said order is estimated as a period of thirty years from January 24, 1956, being a date not later than one year after the final passage of said order, and that said period expires January 24, 1986.

Section 2.
