The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That Charles R. Council be appointed Chairman Pro-tem to act in the absence of L. P. Ward, Chairman.

Ordered: That \$100.00 be paid Mrs Annie Lou Cowan from the Out Door Poor Fund for July and August board for Mrs Eva Hunt.

Ordered: That \$845.00 be allowed yearly for supplementing premiums for Life Insurance for County Employees.

Ordered: That the salary of Josephine Ray, County Accountant, be increased \$20.00 per month.

Ordered: That Drew Miller, Route 1, Tabor City, South Williams Township, be given a refund in the amount of \$2.00. He was released from the service in January 1955 and poll tax was charged in error.

Ordered: That the personal property valuation in the amount of \$1317.00 and also \$2.00 poll tax in the name of Charles Blackwell, Bug Hill Township (Loris, Sc. C.) be cancelled and the tax collector be given a release. Part of this man's estate is in N. C. and part in South Carolina; his personal property is all in South Carolina. Year 1956.
