

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office May 6, 1957 at 10 A. M. it being first Monday:

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That real estate listed in the name of Elery Woodrow Britt & Wife Lois C. Britt in the town of Whiteville as one lot \$4930.00 and adjoining lot \$83.00 be combined as one house and lot valued at \$2500.00 for year 1957 and that this valuation be retroactive to and including 1954 and payment of taxes for the year 1954, 1955, 1956 be accepted upon said reduced valuation and the tax collector be given a release for each of said years on a valuation of \$2513.00.

Ordered: That Public Assistance Budgets be approved as presented by Alice S. Wright, Supt. Public Welfare. This includes Old Age Assistance, Aid To Dependent Children, and Aid to Permanently and Totally Disabled and Blind Budget.

Ordered: That the General County Fund pay to the Bond Interest And Redemption Fund \$30,000.00 which was a loan made to the General County Fund a number of years ago from the Bond Interest & Redemption Fund and has never been repaid.

Ordered: That poll tax for the years 1955 & 1956 be refunded Bennie Bostic, Bogue Township. He was in service for these years.

Ordered: That the Tax Collector be given a release on a valuation of \$200.00 for taxes listed in the name of Herbert G. Scull, Ransom Township for the year 1956. This error of \$200.00 was made in copying abstract wrong.

Ordered: That Thomas E. Nance be exempt from paying poll tax in Tatum Township due to disability. (One Arm)

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Addie Mitchell, Waccamaw Township, be cancelled for the years 1934, 1935 & 1936. This notation was on the scroll in 1936 but the tax collector did not get all of the order.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of M. L. Ross, Lees Township for the year 1951 be cancelled, due to error in listing.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Evans Spaulding, Bogue Township for the years 1937 through 1942 be accepted at par.

Ordered: That the Sheriff summon the following good and lawful men and women to serve as jurors for the following term of Court: June 17, 1957
