Whereas, Columbus County is the owner of the hospital located in the Town of Whiteville, and being operated under a lease by the Board of Trustees of the Columbus County Hospital; and whereas, said Board of Trustees propose to make additions to said hospital at an estimated cost of \$300,000.00, 50% of which would be furnished with Federal funds, 22% with State funds and the remaining 28% with local funds; and whereas, the said trustee of the hospital have on hand the 28% which would be deposited and earmarked for this purpose, and it has been requested that the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County pass a resolution approving and authorising the proposed expansion project.

Now, Therefors, it is upon motion of Commissioner Council, seconded by Commissioner Thompson and unanimously passed:

Resolved that the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County go on record as approving and authorizing said expansion project and the use of any funds that the Trustees of the Columbus County Hospital have on hand for said parpose.
