

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office July 1, 1957 at 10 A. M. it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That the Waccamaw Bank & Trust Company, Whiteville, N. C. be named depository for all school funds and that the First National Bank of Whiteville be named depository for other county funds.

Ordered: That the advertisement of the Court Calendar be divided between The News Reporter, Columbus County News, and The Tabor City Tribune.

Ordered: That Recorders Court Judge Sankey W. Robinson be paid \$100.00 per week effective July 1, 1957. It is further ordered that this be placed on a six months trial basis in order that all concerned will be able to see how the act passed by the legislature will affect the county.

Ordered: That Columbus County enter into an agreement with Carolina Power & Light Company concerning the amount of electricity used at the Boarding Home. (Copy of agreement filed)

Ordered: That the Senior Sanitarian, and two public health nurses at the Health Department be raised to meet the requirements of the merit system.

Bids for the County Library were received and opened at 2 P. M.

Ordered: That the contract for the County Library be awarded to Burns & Fipps Construction Company who submitted a low bid of \$6,158.00.

Ordered: That Horace Shipman be allowed to pay on 3 lots valued at \$300.00 and propertinate share of personal valuation for the year 1954 on tax listed in the name of Mrs W. J. Bussey, Bogue Township.

Whereas, Columbus County is the owner of the hospital located in the Town of Whiteville, and being operated under a lease by the Board of Trustees of the Columbus County Hospital; and whereas, said Board of Trustees propose to make additions to said hospital at an estimated cost of \$300,000.00, 50% of which would be furnished with Federal funds, 22% with State funds and the remaining 28% with local funds; and whereas, the said trustee of the hospital have on hand the 28% which would be deposited and earmarked for this purpose, and it has been requested that the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County pass a resolution approving and authorizing the proposed expansion project.

Now, Therefore, it is upon motion of Commissioner Council, seconded by Commissioner Thompson and unanimously passed:

Resolved that the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County go on record as approving and authorizing said expansion project and the use of any funds that the Trustees of the Columbus County Hospital have on hand for said purpose.
