The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That Mrs Julittie Kelly be allowed \$10.00 to help with expenses until the Welfare Department can check into the case.

Ordered: That the Capital Outlay Budget for the year 1957-58 for Whiteville City Schools in the amount of \$29,126.26 be approved as presented by L. A. Bruton, Supt.

Ordered: That the County Accountant be authorized to cancel all county checks listed as outstanding on the bank statements through June 30, 1956.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of E. S. Moore, Bolton Township, as 6 acres, valued at \$119.00 be cancelled for the years 1942 and prior upon the payment of taxes due for the years 1943 through 1956, on account of a portion of these lands being doubled listed.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Aggie Teachey, Whiteville Township, for the years 1942 and prior be accepted at par.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of G. D. Nye, Waccamaw Township, for the years 1925 - 1927 and 1928 be cancelled as this was double listed.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Mrs Ollie Holloman, Bogue Township be cancelled for the years 1939 through 1956 as they were double listed.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Mrs Geo. E. Jolly, Bogue Township, for the years 1934 through 1940 be cancelled as this was double listed.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Mrs Ida Pierce, Bogue Township, for the years 1927 through 1945 be cancelled as this property is or was owned by County.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Penny Webb, Bogue Township, for the years 1937, 1938, 1939 and 1940 be cancelled as this was double listed.

Ordered: That taxes listed in the name of Thomas Pridgen Heirs in Tatum Township, be divided among his heirs into 12 parts as shown by 1957 tax listing, and that tax be segregated and the lands belonging to each said heirs be released from the lein of taxes for the years 1955 & 1956 upon the payment by said heirs of 1/12 the taxes due thereon for said years.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO DEFINE AND IMPOSE A LICENSE TAX ON ITINERANT PHOTOGRAPHERS AND THEIR AGENTS AND EMPLOYEES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. It is hereby declared that it is in the public interest to require the licensing of persons practicing the profession or occupation of an itinerant photographer and to license an itinerant photographer's employees, agents or servants. An itinerant photographer is defined to be a person, partnership or corporation having no regularly established place of business in this state who personally or through officers, employees, agents or servants goes from town to town or from place to place within a town other than within the county of his residence, soliciting the making of photographic pictures or reproductions with a view to selling the same to the persons solicited. Unless duly licensed as hereinafter provided, it shall be unlawful for any person to practice as an itinerant photographer to engage in business in behalf of an itinerant photographer. The words "regular established place of business" are defined to mean a place of business open to the public at least two days a week for not less than four hours daily and having one or more persons in charge thereof, and at which place the same person has the intent to continue in business for at least six consecutive months.

Section 2. Any person who practices the profession or occupation of an itinerant photographer in this state, whether as principle, officer, employee, agent or servant, and whether engaged in soliciting or in one or more of the operations involved in the making of photographic pictures or reproductions, shall obtain a license as hereinafter provided, paying therefor an annual fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00). All the provisions of the Revenue Act applicable to other state license, taxes not inconsistent herewith shall be applicable with respect to the license tax herein provided.

Section 3. Counties, cities and towns may levy a license tax on each person taxed under this act not in excess of that levied by the state.

Section 4. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This act shall become effective August 5, 1957.

ORDINANCE

ITINERANT PHOTOGRAPHERS (A) Every person, Firm, Corporation or Partnership engaged in the practice of Photography, but having no regularly established place of business located in this state, and who personally or through officers, employees, agents or servants, goes from town to town or from place to place within this county, soliciting the making of photographic picture or reproductions with a view to selling the same, shall apply for and obtain from the county Tax Collector

a license for the privilege of engaging in such business in the county and pay annually for said license a tax of one hundred dollars (\$100) for each individual photographer, agent, servant, representative or employee so engaged.

(B) The license Tax imposed by this ordinance shall apply to every person who practices the profession or occupation of an itinerant photographer in this ^{COUNTY} ~~city~~ whether as principal, officer employee, agent or servant and whether engaged in soliciting or in one or more of the operations involved in the making of photographic pictures or reproductions.

(C) The words "regularly established place of business" are defined to mean a place of business open to the public at least two days a week for not less than four hours daily and having one or more persons in charge thereof, and at which place the same person has the intent to continue in business for at least six consecutive months.
