S. highway No. 13, be extended southward from Goldsboro, North Carolina, and be routed over the present U. S. Highway No. 701 from Clinton, North Carolina to Charleston, South Carolina and Whereas, U. S. Highway 701 meets all requirements of Federal specifications and the extension of U. S. Highway 13, along the present route of Highway 701 would be a mid-way point between U. S. Highways 301 and 18, thus sharing existing burdensome North-South traffic, and also provide a shorter route from the North-East to Southern extremities of the country, and

Whereas, it is felt that U. S. Highway 701, being a short cut-off dues not attract the tourist traffic which might be brought through this area with the routing of a Federal Highway, such as U. S. 13, originating in the heavily populated areas of the North-East, and it is believed that resulting tourist traffice would releive congestion of traffic on U. S. 301

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the North Carolina State Highway Commission be, and is hereby petitioned to indorse and secure the concurrence of Federal Authorities for the extension of U. S. Highway No. 13, to follow the present routing of U. S. Highway No. 701, from Clinton, North Carolina to Charleston, South Carolina, for the overall advantage and convenience of the general public.

A copy of this resolution to be forwarded to the North Carolina State Highway Commission, and that they be urged to designate the present U. S. Highway No. 701, as U. S. Highway No. 13.
