ROAD PETITIONS: Whiteville Township - Road runs from the brickyard to 701 Bypass near the New Dixie Warehouse.

Chadbourn Township - Road runs from old Stake Road to Chadbourn Road that runs along side of the A.C.L. Railroad and is known as the Community Road.

South Williams Township - Road runs from 701 highway to the Mill Branch paved road and is known as The John Mills Road.

Whiteville Township - Road runs from U.S. Highway 74-76 about 1 mile west of Whiteville to the Whiteville Smyrna Road and is known as Short-cut from 74-76 to Whiteville Smyrna Road.

Upon motion of Commissioner Bartley, seconded by Commissioner Council, and unanimously passed, it was ordered that the following ordinance be enacted, and that copy thereof be posted at the Court House door for ten days, and notice thereof given through the newspapers, said ordinance being as follows:

Be it ordained by the Board of County Commissioners, in meeting duly assembled, that on and after December 15, 1957, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to solicit, sell, or in any manner attempt to secure the sale of insurance in the Court House Building, or upon any of the Court House property adjoining same, and any person violating the terms of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined or imprisoned in the discretion of the court.

The Columbus County Board Of Comminnioners, in meeting duly assembled, being of the opinion that the application for a raise in rates by the Carolina Telephone and Telegraph Company should be denied, as being unreasable and would work an unjust burden upon the citizens of Columbus County, and especially those who have been encouraged to get rural telephones lines which are sorely needed for emergencies and protection; and whereas; it is the opinion of the citizens of Columbus County that the Carolina Telephone and Telegraph Company upon its last sale of common stock of said corporation could have obtained by sale on the public market a sufficient sum to have the improvements they now claim they need the money for; and whereas, tha citizens of Columbus County, which is mainly a rural Gounty, and passing through astage of declining revenues, and that the request for a raise in rates would work an unjustifiable burden upon the telephone users in said County, and it is sincerely felt and belived that returns to investors in ^{said} the Company should not be increased;

Now, therefore, the Columbus C ounty Board of Commissioners, ia meeting duly assembled, unami^{ly} petition the Utilities Commission that said increase be refused; that a copy of this resolution be sent to the chairman of the Utilities Commission and a copy delivered to the newspapers.
