The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That Mrs Alma Bullock and Miss Alice Lowe be reappointed to serve on the  
the Columbus County Library Board for a term expiring June 30, 1964.

Ordered: That \$275.00 be paid from the General County Fund for letters on the  
County Library .

Ordered: The burial expenses for indigent patients be raised to \$60.00 for  
adults and \$40.00 for children from infant to 6 years old .

Sealed Bids were opened for printing forms for the new Tax Machine . The  
News Reporter Company, Whiteville, N. C. submitted low bid .

Ordered: That Helen Weir , Clerical Assistant in the Tax Collectors office,  
be given a check for \$ 50.00 for additional services rendered during the year 1958.

Ordered: That Jerry Byrd, Whiteville Township be given a refund for \$ 1.98 for  
the year 1958 . This was charged through error , late listing penalty.

Ordered: That the valuation on a 40 acre tract listed in the name of Van L.  
Benson, Ransom Township be reduced from \$800.00 to \$300.00 and the Tax Collector be  
given a release on a \$500.00 valuation for the year 1958. This was an error in tran-  
ferring value from 1957 .

Ordered: That Taxes listed in the name of M. Shaw Heirs, Waccamaw Township  
for the years 1942 and prior be accepted at Tax Certificate value .

Ordered: That lands listed in name of A. R. Spaulding in Waccamaw Township for  
years 1928 through 1934 be segregated as listed for year 1935 in name of owner as
