Veteran.

Upon Motion of Commissioner Lacy R. Thompson, seconded by Commissioner
W. B. Buffkin and carried the order of March 26, 1960 concerning the selling
of bonds for school purposes was rescinded.

Upon Motion of Commissioner W. B. Buffkin, seconded by Commissioner A. O.
Burns it is ordered that the County use its borrowing power for this fiscal year
and borrow \$75,000.00 from the State Literary Fund with \$37,500.00 going to
Whiteville City Schools and \$37,500.00 to the County School Unit. It is ^{also} ordered
that \$2,500.00 be given Whiteville City School from the General County Fund.
