The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the county farm be leased to A. B. Dawsey, Sr. for a period of three years at \$1200. per year. County Attorney, Sankey W. Robinson was directed to prepare the lease agreement. There was a discussion regarding rent due from Mr. Dawsey and it was agreed that a balance of \$200 remains to be paid by him.

Ordered: that Charles Lee Simpson be appointed Constable from Ransom Township.

Ordered: that the Social Security field representatives be allowed to use the Courthouse Annex Auditorium on Monday and Thursday of each week without charge.

Ordered: that the resignation of Deputy Sheriff A. J. Eason be accepted as of June 30th.

Ordered: that R. C. Soles, Jr. be paid a fee of \$100 for one month's legal service to the Welfare Department. It was requested that the Welfare Board discuss the need of this special legal service and make recommendation to the Board of Commissioners for their further action.

Ordered: that the following resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, Dr. Floyd Johnson has rendered invaluable service to the citizenry of Columbus County for a period of over forty years through his devoted and unselfish dedication to his duties as Columbus County Health Officer; and

WHEREAS, through his leadership the Columbus County Health Department has progressed to its position as among the best in North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to commemorate such leadership as has been exemplified in the person of Dr. Floyd Johnson,

Upon motion made and duly seconded, the following order was unanimously passed:

"It is therefore ordered: That the Columbus County Health Center Building be named 'THE FLOYD JOHNSON MEMORIAL HEALTH CENTER,' and it is further ordered that a brass plaque with the name so inscribed be placed thereon."

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Dr. Floyd Johnson.
