Ordered: that the chairman and clerk be authorized to release the December salary checks of the county employees on December 20th.

Ordered: that the county offices be closed for the Christmas holidays December 23rd, 24th, 25th, and 26th.

Ordered: that all county employees be re-appointed for the year 1962 and that the surety bonds of various employees be approved as recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds and the Clerk of Court.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Jesse Godwin, Chadbourn Township, for the year 1961, be reduced in value by \$400. A 1956 Ford truck was valued at \$905. and should have been valued at \$505.00.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of D. F. Wright, Jr. in Williams Township on one lot valued at \$600 be cancelled for the years 1959, 1960, and 1961. There was an order passed May 4, 1959 by the Board of County Commissioners cancelling all taxes from 1950 through 1958; however, a copy of this order apparently did not reach the tax supervisor.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Ruby Gore Norris, Bug Hill Township, be cancelled for the year 1961. This was due to a car being listed both in South Williams and in Bug Hill Townships.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of M. B. Ladson, Bolton Township, be cancelled for the years 1935 and 1939. Scroll notation says double listed.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Rabon's Grocery Store, Chadbourn Township, be reduced in value by \$1,160.00 for the year 1961.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Elbert Suggs, Bug Hill Township, be segregated so that Ellen Suggs may pay the tax on a 58-acres tract valued at \$500.00 for the years 1949 through 1958, and at \$600.00 for the years 1959, 1960, and 1961-- this tract known as home and farm; and on a 2-acre tract valued at \$13.00 for the years 1950 through 1958, and at \$16.00 for the years 1959 through 1961-- this tract known as "J. Ed Long;" and that upon payment of the above tax and a proportionate part of the personal property tax for said years, this 58-acre tract and this 2-acre tract be free from tax lien for the above years.
