The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., February 5, 1962, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

In anticipation of the seasonal work which will be available during the summer months, it is ordered that the distribution of surplus food commodities to the needy be discontinued May 1, 1962.

Ordered: that John Hines be given a check in the amount of \$10.00 from the out door poor fund.

Ordered: that Mrs. Carl Hardee be employed as custodian of the courthouse annex at the same salary her late husband received.

Ordered: that all outstanding checks through December 31, 1958 be charged off the records of county auditor.

A delegation from Central High School, led by Alexander Smith, appeared before the Board concerning building conditions that exist at Central High School. After hearing the discussion, the Board of Commissioners referred them to the City Board of Education.

Ordered: that a check from the out door poor fund in the amount of \$21.00 be issued to the Chadbourn Motel to help the town of Chadbourn defray the cost of an emergency welfare case during the month of December.

Ordered: that the auditor refund Dennis Williams certain bond fees due him which have been paid to the county treasurer by Justices of the Peace and various towns of the county.

Ordered: that the county attorney be authorized to purchase flight maps of Columbus County to be used in the tax revaluation program.

Ordered: that Robert C. Schulken be employed as attorney for the county welfare department at a salary of \$300.00 per month retroactive to January 1, 1962.

Ordered: that the Surplus Food Supervisor be permitted to employ an assistant at his own discretion.

Ordered: that the purchasing agent be authorized to sell the county barn and water tank, and to direct the purchaser to clean up the debris.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of J. A. Jarvis, Tatum Township, be reduced in valuation by \$750.00 for the year 1961. A trailer was erroneously listed at \$1,000 rather than \$250.00.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Gordon G. Best, Welches Creek Township, be segregated so that William Ellis may pay on one lot valued for tax purposes at \$60.00 for the years 1959, 1960, and 1961, and that upon payment of said years' tax and a proportinate part of the personal property tax, that this one lot will be clear of tax lien for above years.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of John Freeman Heirs, Bolton Township, be cancelled for the years 1947 through 1961. Scroll says "county owns."

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of J. R. Powell, Williams Township, be segregated so that Miles Williams may be allowed to pay on $\frac{1}{2}$ acre of a 3-acre tract; this half-acre to be valued for tax purposes for the years 1957 and 1958 at \$47.00. Upon payment of taxes for the above two years, along with a proportinate part of the personal property tax, this $\frac{1}{2}$ acre will be free of tax lien for the above years.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Thelbert Powell, Williams Township, be segregated so that Miles Williams may be allowed to pay taxes for the years 1959, 1960, and 1961 on $\frac{1}{2}$ -acre of a 3-acre tract; this $\frac{1}{2}$ -acre to be valued for tax purposes at \$47.00 for the above years. Upon payment of the above tax and a proportinate part of personal property for the above years, this $\frac{1}{2}$ -acre tract will be clear of tax lien for said years.

Ordered: that Charles R. Parker, Ransom Township, be given a refund of \$14.63 due to the fact that a 1937 John Deere tractor was valued at \$850.00 rather than \$100.00.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release on a 30-acre tract of land listed in the name of Henry Bryant Heirs, Bolton Township, on a valuation of \$1350.00 for the years 1938 through 1946, and \$1485.00 for the years 1947 through 1958, and on \$1780.00 valuation for the years 1959, 1960, and 1961. This property, through error, was originally listed in 1938 at \$1500 rather than \$150. This 30-acre tract is to be valued for tax purposes in 1962 at \$300.00.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Henry Bryant, Bolton Township, be cancelled for the year 1924. This was double listed.

Ordered: that the tax supervisor be ordered to cancel from the records a 6-acre tract of land listed in the name of Henry Bryant, Ransom Township.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Annie Swinson Leach, Tatum Township, be cancelled on a $2\frac{1}{2}$ -acre tract of land for the years 1938, and 1941 through 1961. This was double listed.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Lucinda Robinson, Tatum Township, be cancelled for the years 1942 through 1961. This was a double listing.

Ordered: that the Atlantic Coastline Railroad be given a refund in the amount of \$1,426.31. This was due to an overpayment of prepaid 1961 taxes.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Sandy Daniels, Ransom Township, for the year 1960, be reduced in value by \$6,000 and that he be relieved of a late listing penalty in the amount of \$13.69. This was due to a 19-acre tract of land, valued at \$1,000, being listed for six years through error.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Sandy Daniels, Ransom Township, be reduced in valuation by \$1,000 for the year 1961. This was due to a 19-acre tract, valued at \$1,000 being listed to him through error. This 19-acre tract is to be dropped for the year 1962.

WHEREAS it is understood that the North Carolina Highway Commission has had under consideration for a number of years the erection of a new bridge over the Cape Fear River at Wilmington and,

WHEREAS such a bridge would aid the commercial and industrial development of Columbus County and the surrounding area and,

WHEREAS construction of said bridge would contribute much to the development of the State Ports located in Wilmington, thereby contributing to the whole industrial growth of North Carolina

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Columbus County Board of Commissioners does hereby respectfully request the North Carolina Highway Commission to proceed with the construction of said bridge immediately.

Ordered: that the Chairman and Clerk be authorized to sign bond, interest, and redemption fund voucher in the amount of \$2,281.45 to pay the following debt service due:
