The/Chairman announced that a special meeting of the Board of Commissioners had been called to be held at 2 o'clock p.m., at the Courthouse in Whiteville, North Carolina, for the purpose of taking any necessary action in connection with the calling of a special bond election in the Riegelwood Sanitary District, and act upon such other business as may come before the Board, and that two days' written notice substantially in the following form had been given to each of the Board members and a copy thereof had been posted on the Courthouse bulletin board on April 17, 1962, and has remained so posted:

Thereupon Commissioner Buffkin, Vice Chairman, introduced the following resolution which was read:

RESOLUTION CALLING A SPECIAL BOND
ELECTION IN RIEGELWOOD SANITARY DISTRICT

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Columbus:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners has determined and does hereby find and declare that it has received certified copies of three resolutions passed by the Sanitary District Board of the Riegelwood Sanitary District on April 19, 1962, entitled:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$110,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION WATER BONDS OF RIEGELWOOD SANITARY DISTRICT

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$10,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT AND APPARATUS BONDS OF RIEGELWOOD SANITARY DISTRICT, and

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF THE SANITARY DISTRICT BOARD TO PUBLISH THE BOND RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$110,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION WATER BONDS OF RIEGELWOOD SANITARY DISTRICT AND THE BOND RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$10,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT AND APPARATUS BONDS OF RIEGELWOOD SANITARY DISTRICT, AND REQUESTING THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE COUNTY OF COLUMBUS TO CALL AN ELECTION UPON THE ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS AUTHORIZED THEREBY.

Section 2. A special bond election is hereby ordered to be held in the Riegelwood Sanitary District, in Columbus County, North Carolina, on Tuesday, June 5, 1962, between 6:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, at which there shall be submitted to the qualified registered voters of said Riegelwood Sanitary District the following two propositions:

1. Issuing not exceeding \$110,000 General Obligation Water Bonds for the purpose of providing funds for the acquisition and extension of a water system for the District, as authorized by a bond resolution adopted by the Sanitary District Board of said District on April 19, 1962, and the levy of a tax for the payment thereof.
2. Issuing not exceeding \$10,000 General Obligation Fire Fighting Equipment and Apparatus Bonds for the purpose of providing funds for the purchase of fire fighting equipment and apparatus for the District, as authorized by a bond resolution adopted by the Sanitary District Board of said District on April 19, 1962, and the levy of a tax for the payment thereof.

Section 3. There shall be a new registration of voters for said election, the books for such new registration to be open from 9:00 a.m. until sunset on each day beginning Saturday, May 12, 1962, and ending Saturday, May 26, 1962. On each Saturday during such period said books shall be kept open at the polling place. Saturday, June 2, 1962, shall be Challenge Day.

Section 4. Notice of said election and new registration shall be published once a week for three successive weeks, the first publication to be at least thirty (30) days before the close of the registration books, in The News Reporter, a newspaper published in Columbus County and circulating in said District, which notice shall be in substantially the following form:

A special bond election will be held between 6:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, Tuesday, June 5, 1962, at which there will be submitted to the qualified registered voters of the Riegelwood Sanitary District, in Columbus County, North Carolina, which District comprises the territory hereinafter described, the following two propositions:

1. Issuing not exceeding \$110,000 General Obligation Water Bonds for the purpose of providing funds for the acquisition and extension of a water system for the District, as authorized by a bond resolution adopted by the Sanitary District Board of said District on April 19, 1962, and the levy of a tax for the payment thereof.
2. Issuing not exceeding \$10,000 General Obligation Fire Fighting Equipment and Apparatus Bonds for the purpose of providing funds for the purchase of fire fighting equipment and apparatus for the District, as authorized by a bond resolution adopted by the Sanitary District Board of said District on April 19, 1962, and the levy of a tax for the payment thereof.

The boundary lines of said Riegelwood Sanitary District are as follows:

BEGINNING at a point where the Northern right of way line (100.0 feet from its center line) of the Seaboard Airline Railroad intersects the center line of N. C. Highway #87 (said Highway right of way being 100.0 feet in width) said intersection being just Northwestward of Acme, N. C.; running thence from said beginning point and along the Northern right of way line of said Seaboard Airline Railroad North 66 deg. 04 min. West 84.93 feet to a point in the Southwestern right of way line of said N.C. Highway #87; running thence along the Northern right of way line of said railroad North 66 deg. 04 min. West 5,744.3 feet to a concrete monument in the western line of the formerly Cross Seed Co's Koester Tract, said monument being located North 34 deg. 14 min. East 101.64 feet from a point in the center line of said railroad right of way which said point is 122 feet Eastwardly from the said Seaboard Airline Railroads mile post #345; running thence along a well marked line, the Western line of said formerly Cross Seed Co's Koester Tract North 34 deg. 14 min. East 418.0 feet to an old stone marked "M"; running thence North 33 deg. 48 min. East 705.4 feet to a concrete monument replacing an old pipe; said pipe being just Southwest of the Cornwallis Road; running thence North 43 deg. 19 min. East 995.7 feet to a concrete monument in the Southeast right of way line (30.0 feet from its center line) of the Armour Road; running thence along the Southeastern right of way line of said Road North 47 deg. 02 min. East 269.6 feet to a concrete monument; running thence same course North 47 deg. 02 min. East 8.5 feet to the run of Pretty Branch at a point opposite a culvert under the pavement of said road; running thence Southwardly along the run of said branch to an old concrete monument; said monument being the following courses and distances (as measured in general along the run of said branch) from the preceding point:

South 23 deg. 11 min. East 153.0 feet

monument in a Southeastern corner of Burns Estate line; running thence along one of his Southeastern lines North 47 deg. 20 min. East 1,394.8 feet to the Southwestern right of way line of aforementioned N. C. Highway #87; running thence same course North 47 deg. 20 min. East 19.14 feet to an old concrete monument inside the right of way of said Highway; running thence same course

North 47 deg. 20 min. East 32.11 feet to the center line of said Highway; running thence along the center line of said Highway South 30 deg. 00 min. East 1,962.1 feet to a point, said point being in the extended Southeastern right of way line of the road leading to the Riegel Paper Co. Mill (if said road right of way were extended Southwestwardly); running thence along said extended right of way line North 47 deg. 41 min. East 51.18 feet to a point where the Northeastern right of way line of said Highway intersects the Southeastern right of way line of said road to Mill, said point being also 50.0 feet from the center line of said Mill road; running thence along the Southeastern right of way line of said road North 47 deg. 41 min. East 1,311.0 feet to a railroad spike in the Southern edge of a 50.0 foot pipe-line right of way of the raw water line running from Lock #1 on the Cape Fear River to the City of Wilmington, N. C. said point being 35.0 feet Southwardly from the center line of the present pipe line; running thence along the Southern edge of said right of way to an iron pipe which is 55.0 feet Westwardly when measured perpendicular to the center of the most Western spur tracts of the Riegel Paper Co., said iron pipe being the following courses and distances as measured in general along the Southern edge of said pipeline right of way from the preceding point, South 51 deg. 31 min. East 176.4 feet, South 53 deg. 46 min. East 293.4 feet, South 54 deg. 52 min. East 291.6 feet and South 55 deg. 55 min. East 205.0 feet to said pipe; running thence Southwardly and parallel to said center line of spur tract and 55.0 feet therefrom to a point where it intersects the Northern right of way line of aforementioned Seaboard Airline Railroad, said last point being the following courses and distances from the preceding point: South 27 deg. 38 min. West 87.9 feet to the beginning of a curve to the left; running thence along the arc of said curve to the end of said curve, said point being South 24 deg. 01 min. West 136.68 feet from the preceding point; running thence South 20 deg. 24 min. West 248.9 feet to a point, the beginning of a curve to the right; running thence along the arc of said curve to the end of said curve, said point being South 23 deg. 59 min. 30 Sec. West 52.99 feet from the preceding point; running thence South 27 deg. 35 min. West 192.1 feet to a point, the beginning of a curve to the left; running thence along the arc of said curve to the end of said curve, said point being South 4 deg. 13 min. 30 sec. West 842.1 feet from the preceding point; running thence South 19 deg. 08 min. East 1,885.0 feet to said intersection with the Northern right of way line of aforementioned Seaboard Airline Railroad; running thence along the Northern right of way line of said Seaboard Airline Railroad North 66 deg. 04 min. West 450.5 feet to a point where said Northern line intersects the Northeast right of way line of aforementioned N. C. Highway #87; running thence along the Northern right of way line of said Seaboard Airline Railroad North 66 deg. 04 min. West 84.93 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

Each of the propositions hereinabove set forth contains a statement of the purpose for which the bonds are authorized by the resolution referred to in such proposition.

If said bonds shall be issued a tax will be levied upon all taxable property within said Riegelwood Sanitary District sufficient to pay the principal of and the interest on said bonds.

A new registration of voters has been ordered and no one will be permitted to vote unless registered anew. The books for such new registration will be open from 9:00 a.m. until sunset on each day beginning Saturday, May 12, 1962, and ending Saturday, May 26, 1962. On each Saturday during such registration period said books will be kept open at the polling place. Saturday, June 2, 1962, is Challenge Day.
