Negro County Agent John Spaulding, and negro Home Demonstration Agent, Dorothy Valentine appeared before the Board to present their budget estimate for 1962-63. It was ordered that \$35.00 be appropriated in the 1962-63 budget for the negro county agent's expense to the 4-H Convention.

Ordered: that Dorothy Valentine, Negro Home Demonstration Agent, beggranted a leave of absence of six weeks with pay-- June 18th through July 28th, to attend the 4-H and Sears-Roebuck Foundation in Chevy Chase, Maryland.

Ordered: that Civil Defense Director Wayne be re-imbursed for the travel expense of five students to Civil Defense School in Wilmington.

Ordered: that the Azae-Mellia Garden Club be allowed to use the County Library property for a beautification project.

Ordered: that J. Leamon Long, Courthouse Janitor, be paid at the rate of \$1.50 per hour to make the necessary repairs to a building which the county recently acquired adjacent to the Courthouse Annex; that Mr. Long serve as janitor for this building, and that his salary be increased to \$225.00 per month effective May 1, 1962.

Leonard Killian of the Forest Service appeared before the Board to request an additional \$1,000.00 for their 1962-63 operating expenses.
