The following business was transacted:

Negro County Agent John Spaulding, and negro Home Demonstration Agent, Dorothy Valentine appeared before the Board to present their budget estimate for 1962-63. It was ordered that \$35.00 be appropriated in the 1962-63 budget for the negro county agent's expense to the 4-H Convention.

Ordered: that Dorothy Valentine, Negro Home Demonstration Agent, be granted a leave of absence of six weeks with pay-- June 18th through July 28th, to attend the 4-H and Sears-Roebuck Foundation in Chevy Chase, Maryland.

Ordered: that Civil Defense Director Wayne be re-imbursed for the travel expense of five students to Civil Defense School in Wilmington.

Ordered: that the Azae-Mellia Garden Club be allowed to use the County Library property for a beautification project.

Ordered: that J. Leamon Long, Courthouse Janitor, be paid at the rate of \$1.50 per hour to make the necessary repairs to a building which the county recently acquired adjacent to the Courthouse Annex; that Mr. Long serve as janitor for this building, and that his salary be increased to \$225.00 per month effective May 1, 1962.

Leonard Killian of the Forest Service appeared before the Board to request an additional \$1,000.00 for their 1962-63 operating expenses.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Mrs. L. A. Floyd, Fair Bluff Township, be cancelled on one lot valued at \$34.00 for the years 1952, 1953, 1954, 1955, 1956, 1958, 1959, 1960 and 1961. This lot does not exist.

- ROAD PETITIONS:
1. Bogue Township-- a road known as the "Boone" road, is 1 mile in length and there are 7 occupied homes located on it.
 2. Welches Creek Township-- a part of county road #1722 which runs to the Elkton-Hallsboro H.Way. Road is 2 miles in length and there are 15 occupied homes located on it.
 3. Bogue Township-- Oak Street in the village of Hallsboro.

- ROAD PETITIONS: 4. Bogue Township-- County road #1913 beginning at the railroad crossing of the "Honey Hill" road and intersefs the "Red Bug" road which is hard-surfaced. Road is 1.7 miles in length and there are 6 homes on it. Road needs to be widened.
5. Whiteville Township-- Forest Drive which is in the Inglewood section off H.Way 74-76 West. Road has been surfaced by the developers and they request that it be maintained by the State. Road is .4 mile in length and there are 7 occupied homes on it.
