The following public assistance budgets for the fiscal year 1962-1963 were approved as presented: Aid to Dependent Children, Old Age Assistance, & Aid to the Permanently & Totally Disabled.

*Revised 6-7-62*  
There was a general discussion of the Social Security Administrative budget for the fiscal year 1962-63. It was ordered that the budget estimates be reduced to fit the estimated revenue derived from the present tax levy of 7.5¢.

The following resolution was introduced and adopted:

WHEREAS, the farmers and other interested landowners in the Chadbourn Drainage District in Columbus County have recognized the flooding problem as a menace to agriculture on the low-lying areas of the watershed and also to people living in and near the watershed,

AND WHEREAS, these interested people have indicated their interest in a concentrated effort to cooperate in the solution of this problem for the benefit of all concerned,

AND WHEREAS, the people in this watershed have requested the Columbus County Board of Commissioners to be one of the sponsors of a watershed and flood prevention project on the said watershed.

We, THEREFORE, authorize L. P. Ward, Sr., Chairman of the Columbus County Board of Commissioners to sign the application for planning assistance under the Watershed Protection and Flood Prevention Act, PL 566.
