The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that C. D. Raper, County Extension Chairman, be reimbursed for his share of travel expense incurred in connection with attendance at the National Association of County Agents in Minneapolis, Minnesota on September 26, 1963.

Ordered: that a check in the amount of \$25.00 be given to Mrs. W. C. Bullard from the Out Door Poor Fund, and a like amount to Mrs. Minnie Cribb.

Ordered: that the Fair Bluff and Lake Waccamaw Fire & Rescue Squadrons be issued a check in the amount of \$250.00 each from the Civil Defense Budget as appropriated for the fiscal year 1963-1964.

Ordered: that the Register of Deeds be authorized to charge a fee of \$2.00 for the recording and release of federal tax liens.

Ordered: that Judge Raymond Mallard be allowed \$500 out of Court Cost for clerical assistance.
