

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., November 4, 1963, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

The budget of Whiteville City Schools for the fiscal year 1963-1964 was approved as presented.

Ordered: that Dr. J. R. Black, Health Director, be authorized to purchase Citizens' Band Radio Units for the Health Department at a cost not to exceed \$1,000, and that at least three bids be secured on these units.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Arthur Leinwand, Whiteville Township, be reduced in value by \$2,662 for the year 1963, and that the tax collector be given a release. It is further ordered that one lot, valued for tax purposes at \$6,662 and listed in the name of Arthur Leinwand, be listed in 1964 at \$4,000.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Mrs. Z. V. Jones, Bolton Township, for the year 1963, be segregated so that Otto Jones may pay taxes for the above year on two lots valued for tax purposes at \$594.00.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of William H. Freeman, Williams Township, for the year 1963, be reduced in value by \$500. A 1952 Chevrolet was listed at \$600 instead of \$100.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Josie Belle Bryant, Ransom Township, on a 23-Acre tract valued at \$346.00 be cancelled for the years 1962 and 1963. A prior order has been written cancelling taxes for the years 1950 through 1961, but this property has inadvertently been continuously listed on the penalty list.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of L. P. Waters, Whiteville Township, be segregated so that Margaret Justice may be permitted to pay the tax for the years 1962 and 1963 on one lot, valued for tax purposes at \$3,162, and that upon payment of the taxes for the years 1962 and 1963, this lot, valued at \$3,162 shall be clear of tax lien for said years. It is further ordered that this lot be listed for the year 1964 to Margaret Justice and valued for tax purposes at \$3,162.00.

1. That, pursuant to Chapter 115A of the General Statutes of North Carolina and The County Finance Act, as amended, the County of Columbus, North Carolina, is hereby authorized to contract a debt, in addition to any and all other debt which said County may now or hereafter have power or authority to contract and in evidence thereof to issue Community College Bonds in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$500,000 for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for the construction of buildings for a community college in Columbus County, including the acquisition of any necessary land and equipment.

2. That a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and the interest on said bonds when due shall be annually levied and collected.

3. That a statement of the County debt for other than school purposes has been filed with the Clerk and is open to public inspection.

4. That this order shall take effect when approved by the voters of the County at an election as provided in The County Finance Act, as amended.

The Board thereupon designated the County Accountant as the officer to make and file with herself as clerk the statement of debt and assessed valuation of the County as required by The County Finance Act, as amended, to be filed before the final passage of the order which was introduced at this meeting.

Thereupon the County Accountant filed with herself as clerk, in the presence of the Board, the statement of debt and assessed valuation as so required.

The order entitled: "ORDER AUTHORIZING \$500,000 COMMUNITY COLLEGE BONDS" was thereupon passed on first reading.

On motion duly made and unanimously carried the Board fixed 10 o'clock A.M., December 9, 1963 as the hour and date for the public hearing upon the foregoing order, and directed the Clerk to publish said order, together with the appended note as required by The County Finance Act, as amended, in the News Reporter not later than the tenth day before said date.
