

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., January 6, 1964, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

J. M. Powell, representative for the Hospital Care Association, Inc. of Durham, N. C., appeared before the Board to discuss an increase in the premium rate of the county Group Hospital Insurance Policy, which will become effective February 1, 1964 due to excessive claims made by the county group. It was ordered that this policy be retained and that the increased premium rate be accepted. It is expressly understood that there will be no change in the schedule of dues applied to this group during the 24-month period following February 1, 1964 per contract with Hospital Care Association, Inc.

A group from the Columbus County Association for Retarded Children appeared before the Board to request the cooperation of the Board in providing funds in the next fiscal year's budget to support the special class for retarded children in this county. The reaction of the Board was favorable, and the group was instructed to meet with the County Board of Education to request that this program be entered into the schools' budget for the next fiscal year- 1964-1965.

Ordered: that the county attorney attend the school for county attorneys at the Institute of Government in February.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Dora Singletary, Western Prong Township, be accepted at par for the years 1951 and 1952.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Helen Brown, Whiteville Township, be accepted at par for the years 1937 through 1952.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Duffie Wilson, Whiteville Township, be accepted at par for the years 1950, 1951, and 1952.

There was a discussion of the coming Community College Bond and Tax Issues, and a constitutional changes to representative government known as "The Little Federal Plan." Realizing Columbus County's great need of a community college and further realizing the need of a representative balance in the State Legislature for Eastern North Carolina, upon motion made and duly seconded, the following resolution was adopted:

"The Board of County Commissioners, individually and collectively as a Board, does support both the Community College Issues and the Constitutional Amendment, and does hereby urge all the eligible voting citizens of Columbus County to go to the polls and support said issues on January 14, 1964."
