The following business was transacted:

Due to an emergency created by lack of heat in the Cowan Rest Home Building and the Welfare offices, the meeting was called to discuss the installation of a new boiler in said building. In view of the fact that the old boiler had blown up; that the welfare department and Cowan Rest Home were left without any heat, and because of the number of elderly residents in the Cowan Rest Home, the commissioners declared that an emergency did exist, and that they were justified in waiving the statutory requirements as to bids for repair or replacement of the heating unit. Therefore, upon consideration of the offer and bid of \$4,132.69 submitted by Whiteville Plumbing Company, Inc. to install a new boiler and make the necessary repairs, which, in the opinion of the Board of Commissioners was reasonable for the work to be performed, upon motion made and duly seconded, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners was authorized to enter into a contract in behalf of the Columbus County Board of Commissioners with Whiteville Plumbing Company, Inc. for the repair and replacement of the heating system at a cost of \$4,132.69.
