Ordered: that the Chadbourn Drainage District be advanced \$5,000; said sum to be repaid from assessments of members of the drainage district or federal funds advanced to said district. It was further ordered that this advance be disbursed by the county accountant pursuant to GS 156-61.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Layus D. Green, Ransom Township, be accepted at par for the years 1950 and 1951.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Layus D. Green, Ransom Township, for the years 1953 through 1963 be accepted at one half the amount of tax certificates plus interest this was due to the house burning on the property.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Humble Oil & Refining Company, Fair Bluff Township, be reduced in value by \$1320.00 for the year 1963. This is due to the real estate value being used twice for the year 1963.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Humble Oil & Refining Company, Ransom Township, be reduced in value by \$5,500.00 for the year 1963. This is due to the real estate value for the year 1963 being included twice.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Willie C. Graham, Fair Bluff Township, be segregated so that S. Scott may be allowed to pay taxes for the years 1962 through 1963 on an Il-acre tract of land, valued for tax purposes at \$396.00, and that upon payment of taxes for said years and a proportionate part of his personal property tax, this particular Il-acre tract shall be clear of tax liens for the above years.
