The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that a check from the out door poor fund in the amount of \$30.00 be given to McNeil Nobles.

Ordered: that a check from the out door poor fund in the amount of \$20.00 be given to Margaret Hammonds.

Ordered: that the sanitation service franchise heretofore granted to S. P. Stanley and T. T. Todd on November 5, 1962, be transferred to T. T. Todd individually.

Ordered: that the Whiteville Beautification Committee be given \$25.00 to be used for landscaping the Courthouse Circle, and that trustees from the county jail be used for such labor as the committee may direct.

Ordered: that \$2,475.00 from the general county fund be advanced to the Community College Board of Trustees, said amount to be repaid from the next fiscal year's levy (1964-1965).

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Myrtis Everett, Ransom Township, be reduced in value by \$2,000 for the year 1963. This was due to said amount being erroneously added.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Ruth L. Britton et al, Whiteville Township, be cancelled for the years 1930, 1933, and 1934. This property was double listed.

- ROAD PETITIONS:
1. Cerro Gordo & Chadbourn Townships: Secondary road #1342 known as the "Hayes" road, is 2.1 miles in length, 16 occupied homes on it.
 2. Tatum Township: Secondary road # 1523, is .7 mile in length, 5 occupied homes on it.
 3. Williams Township: Secondary road #1155, is 1.5 miles in length and there are 5 occupied homes on it.
 4. Bogue Township: Secondary road #1730 known as the "North-east" road, is 6 miles in length and there are 31 occupied homes on it.

- ROAD PETITIONS: 5. Whiteville Township: Spruce Street off Chadbourn Highway.
6. Whiteville Township: Three-fourths of a block in Baldwin Woods beginning with Woodland Drive at the residence of Richard Ray. All traffic to the local swimming pool is over this street-- request that it be paved.

9. Welches Creek Township: Road known as the "Spaulding" road, is .6 mile in length and there are 3 occupied homes on it.
