The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that a check from the out door poor fund in the amount of \$30.00 be given to Pearl N. Powers.

Ordered: that a check from the out door poor fund in the amount of \$15.00 be given to T. B. Register.

Ordered: that poll tax be cancelled on taxes listed in the name of Wilford and Bessie Johnson, South Williams Township, for the year 1963. This man is 56 years of age.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Luther Currie, Welches Creek Township, be cancelled for the years 1961, 1962, and 1963. This property was double-listed for said years.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of James A. Thompson, Bogue Township, be cancelled for the years 1955 through 1963. This was a double-listing.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of W. O. Baldwin, Welches Creek Township, be accepted at par for the year 1949.

The following resolution was introduced and was duly adopted:

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington, in the County of New Hanover, is one of the largest ports on the Eastern Seaboard and New Hanover County contains many resort areas and points of interest, including old historical sites, beautiful gardens and many beautiful beaches;

AND WHEREAS, Charlotte, in Mecklenburg County, is the largest city in North Carolina and one of the fastest growing industrial cities in the Southeast;

AND WHEREAS, Asheville, in Buncombe County, is a great recreational area in our North Carolina Mountains near the Blue Ridge Parkway and also one of our large industrial cities;

AND WHEREAS, North Carolina Highway No. 74 connects all three of these fast growing industrial and resort cities, and freight is constantly shipped by way of N. C. Highway No. 74 from and to Wilmington to and from Charlotte, Asheville and numerous towns and cities along N. C. Highway No. 74;

AND WHEREAS, a portion of N. C. Highway No. 74 is already a four-lane highway;

AND WHEREAS, N. C. Highway No. 74, as well as connecting the three fast growing cities above mentioned and the Southeastern United States, passes through some of the more agricultural counties which have suffered great financial blows due to the shift in the pattern of agricultural crops,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Commissioners of Columbus County desire to respectfully request the N. C. State Highway Commission to give serious and thoughtful consideration to making N. C. Highway No. 74 a four-lane highway all the way from Wilmington in New Hanover County to Asheville in Buncombe County.

2. That the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County desires to point out that, if Highway No. 74 is made into a four-lane highway, Columbus County and also other counties on the Southern Border of North Carolina will experience much greater and much more rapid industrial growth.

3. That the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County further desires to point out that, in its opinion, such a project would encourage all North Carolinians to use the North Carolina beaches and resort areas and the mountain resorts of Western North Carolina rather than go into other states.

4. That North Carolina Highway No. 74, if made into a four-lane highway, keep its present route through Columbus County.

5. That this resolution be entered in the minutes of the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County and that a copy of same be forwarded to the State Highway Commission of North Carolina.
