

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., June 1, 1964 it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that \$1,000 be added to the schools's budget for the fiscal year 1964-1965 for the trainable retarded children's class.

Mr. S. Preston Douglas, CPA of Lumberton, N. C. presented his audit report of all funds and accounts of the Clerk of Superior Court, and it was ordered that this report be accepted as presented. It was further ordered that his contract for this audit be extended for the year 1964 at a rate of \$40.00 per day, plus reasonable travel and subsistence expense, for the services of each accountant engaged in the work.

The Columbus County Committee on Mental Health appeared before the Board to request that money be appropriated in the budget for the fiscal year 1964-1965 for the support of a Mental Health Clinic in Columbus County. Upon motion made, duly seconded, and unanimously carried, it was ordered that the proposed contract between New Hanover and Columbus County for mental health services to Columbus County be adopted and that the necessary money be appropriated in the budget to provide for said contract.

At the request of the State Board of Health, it was ordered that Dr. J. R. Black, Health Director, be permitted to share his services with Brunswick County, giving Columbus $\frac{4}{5}$ of his time and $\frac{1}{5}$ time to Brunswick. It is expressly understood that Columbus County will receive from the State Board of Health a special grant of \$1,000 toward the salary of the Health Director, and that Columbus County's share of his salary will be \$760 less than the county now pays. It is further understood that this arrangement will not affect the organization and structure of the counties participating in this consolidated service. The County Accountant was instructed to adjust the Cooperative Health Budget in accordance with the above order.

It came to the attention of the Board that repairs and improvements were necessary for the continued licensing of the Cowan Rest Home. After full

discussion as to expenditures necessary for said repairs and improvements, and the county funds available, a motion was made, duly seconded and unanimously carried that repairs and improvements recommended by the State Welfare Department to the Cowan Rest Home not be made.

Ordered: that the County Farm, excluding the dwelling on said farm, be advertised for a five-year lease to begin December 1, 1964, and that bids for said lease be opened at 2 p.m., August 3, 1964 at the regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners.

Ordered: that the resignation of Chadbourn Township Constable Charles D. Norris be accepted.

Ordered: that the county employees be granted holidays July 3rd and 4th in recognition of Independence Day.

Dr. Warren Land who has been appointed President of Southeastern Community College, appeared before the Board with the Budget Committee of said college, to discuss the college budget for the ensuing year. After a full discussion, a motion was made, duly seconded, and unanimously carried, that a levy of ten cents (10¢) be incorporated in the 1964 county tax structure for the fiscal year 1964-65 for the Southeastern Community College upon the adoption of a tentative budget to be submitted by the college budget committee.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Margaret R. Brewer, Whiteville Township, be cancelled for the year 1939. This was double listed.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of James A. Burney, Ransom Township, be accepted at par for the year 1951.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Hattie Boyd Heirs, Welches Creek Township, be accepted at par.
