WHEREAS it has come to the attention of the Board that it was recorded in the minutes of March 20, 1961 that the Board, acting as a Board of Equalization and Review, reduced the valuation of E. R. Cruthchfield Heirs, Chadbourn Township, from \$3,762 to \$3,322, and

WHEREAS said action of the Board of Equalization and Review was inadvertently transcribed incorrectly in the minutes as reducing said valuation from \$3,762 to \$1,120, and

WHEREAS said property owner was notified incorrectly as to the action taken by the Board of Equalization & Review, and

WHEREAS said property owner has paid for the year 1961 upon the valuation of \$3,322, and

WHEREAS the Board wishes to compromise with said taxpayer:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the taxpayer be reimbursed the sum of \$42.94 for the year 1961, which would reflect the difference in the valuation of \$3,322 to \$1,120. It is further ordered that this valuation of \$3,322 which correctly reflects the action of the Board of Equalization and Review remain, and be the valuation for said property for the years 1962, 1963, and 1964.

Ordered: that Hubert Norris be authorized to purchase and install two electric water fountains in the courthouse corridors.

Upon motion the meeting adjourned until 9:30 a.m., March 19, 1965 at which time the Board will sit again as a Board of Equalization and Review.
