

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., July 6, 1965 in regular meeting, Monday being a holiday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that a check from the Out Door Poor Fund in the amount of \$25.00 be given to Mrs. Carrie Ward.

Ordered: that the county accountant be authorized to issue a check in the amount of \$35.00 to John M. Spaulding, County Agent, Negro Work, to defray expenses to 4-H Club Week.

Ordered: that the resignation of Commissioner Luther C. Rich be accepted with regrets.

Motion was made by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner Thompson and unanimously carried that T. E. Burns of Acme, N. C. be appointed to the Board of County Commissioners to fill the unexpired term of Commissioner Luther C. Rich.

At 12 o'clock noon the oath of office was administered to T. E. Burns by Lee J. Greer, Clerk of Court.

Ordered: that the Superintendent of County Schools be allowed to remove the old Lunch Room Building from the Cerro Gordo School grounds to the County School Maintenance Shop, said building to be located near the maintenance garage.

Ordered: that Rev. Leo Hawkins of Chadbourn and Mrs. R. N. McCray of Lake Waccamaw be appointed to the Area Mental Health Council.

Ordered: that J. Hubert Norris, Purchasing Agent, be directed to purchase and install air-conditioning unit or units as necessary for the office of Highway Patrol and License Examiner.

Ordered: that a building be rented from Dr. D. W. Pittman for the office of Employment Security subject to the approval of said office.

Atty. J. K. Powell appeared before the Board in behalf of National Spinning Co., and Blue Jeans Corp. regarding taxes for the year 1965.

Ordered: that county funds be deposited in the same banks as were depositories last fiscal year.

Ordered: that funds be appropriated for the purpose of paying salaries and the ordinary expenses of the county during the interval between July 1st and the adoption of the annual Budget Resolution, and that said appropriation be charged to the several appropriations, respectively, hereafter made in the annual appropriation resolution for the 1965-66 year.

Ordered: that a resolution of appreciation be made to Gov. Dan Moore for the appointment of a Columbus County citizen, Senator Carl Meares, to the State Highway Commission.

- ROAD PETITIONS:
1. Bug Hill Township. Road known as N.E. Dothan Extension SR-1108. There are four occupied homes located on it and it is .6 mile in length.
 2. Welches Creek Township. Road begins at McIvor Spaulding's and ends at Jim Corey's property and SR #1719. Road is 1½ miles in length and has ten occupied homes located on it. Is to connect SR #1719 and SR #1722.
 3. Bolton Township. Road leads off H.Way 211 six miles from Bolton; is known as Carolina Avenue. There are ten occupied homes located on it and it is one mile in length.
 4. Welches Creek Township. Secondary Road #1719-- leads from Lonnie High Estate to Spaulding Road. There are forty occupied homes located on it, and it is 3.5 miles in length.
