The following business was transacted:

Mrs. Martha B. Giovinetti, Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor for the Mentally Retarded appeared before the Board regarding the possible formation of a Columbus County Council on Mental Retardation. Action on this matter was deferred until a later meeting.

Ordered: that the resignation of Tommy Glover, Assistant Agriculture Agent, be accepted September 30, 1965 with regrets, and that the appointment of Garland D. McCullen be approved.

Pursuant to GS 20-280 of the General Statutes of N. C., William Jesse Long filed with the County Board of Commissioners proof of financial responsibility as evidenced by auto policy issued by the Insurance Company of North America, Philadelphia, Pa., No. NAM 71-32-34, said policy being in force until August 20, 1966.

A road petition requesting the state to maintain roads from 701 by pass to warehouses in the town of Tabor City was referred to District Engineer E. L. Green.

Ordered: that the pay of court officer be increased to \$15.00 per day effective September 1st.

Ordered: that the following general county records be destroyed by burning in accordance with GS 121-5: 1954-55 and prior years bank statements, cancelled checks, deposits, county bills and claims with invoices and supporting data.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Gray Williamson, Whiteville Township, be segregated into twenty-four parcels, and that upon payment by or on behalf of the listing tax payer of the taxes on any parcel or parcels sought to be released with penalties and interest thereon, plus all personal property, poll, and dog taxes owed by said tax payer with interest and penalties thereon, and upon payment of the said taxes, penalties, and interest thereon, the tax collector is authorized to release said parcel or parcels from tax lien-- pursuant to GS 105-376.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Joseph W. Floyd, Whiteville Township, be accepted at par for the years 1960 and 1961.

Ordered: that taxes for the year 1965 listed in the name of Jerry Godwin, Lees Township, be cancelled due to a 1964 2-Door Cheville being mistakenly listed by a relative. Said taxpayer furnished proof that this car was listed in the state of Alaska for 1965.

Ordered: that the sheriff summon the following good and lawful men and women to serve as jurors at the following terms of court:
